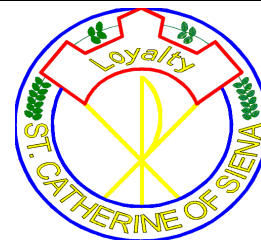

Congratulations to Year 2 for having the best attendance this week.

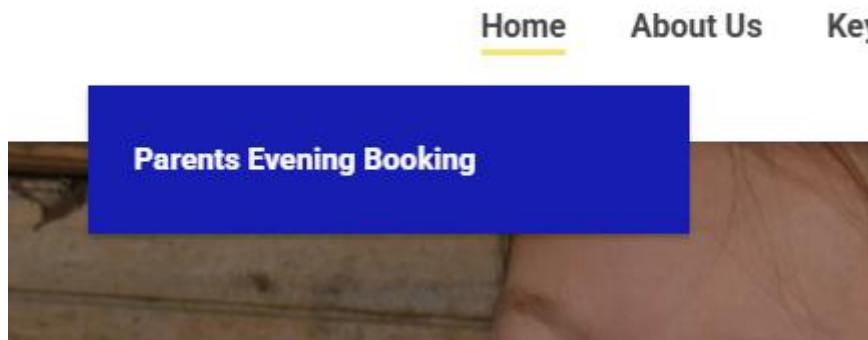

Parent/Teacher Meetings will take place on Tuesday 28th April for all our classes. The system is an online system where you can book an appointment time with your child's class teacher. Providing we have an up-to-date email address you should have received an email, from Juniper Education, with details to set up a password. From the school website hover over 'Home' and you should see the Parent Evening Booking link



Logging in

You can access our booking system at any time using the link on the link below:

You will be prompted to log in by entering your email address and password. If you have not yet set your password, you can request a password reset email by clicking '**Forgot your password.**' You should use the email address you have registered with the school.

Making a Booking

The child you are booking for will show in the top right-hand corner of the screen. If you have more than one child at our school, you will see a circle for each child. Simply click on the relevant circle to select the child you want to make a booking for.

Find the teacher and time you would like to book and click to reserve the time slot. The selection will show in green with the word "**RESERVED.**" The time allocated for each slot will be automatically populated.

Please note: the slot will only be reserved for 10 minutes.

To confirm the reservation you will need to click on the save button in the bottom right corner.

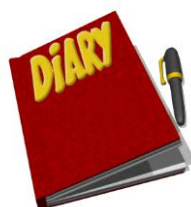
The children will leave school at lunchtime and return at the end of the day.
