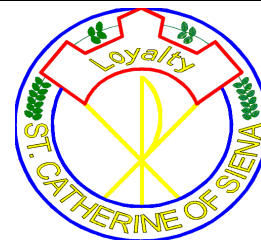

Parent - Teacher Meetings



Parent/Teacher Meetings will take place on Tuesday 28th April for all our classes. The system is an online system where you can book an appointment time with your child's class teacher. Providing we have an up-to-date email address you should have received an email, from Juniper Education, with details to set up a password. From the school website hover over 'Home' and you should see the Parent Evening Booking link.

Due to unforeseen circumstances we are having to cancel the Year 5 parent/teacher meetings, **for the afternoon session only**, on Tuesday 28th April, the morning session will still take place. The afternoon session has been rescheduled to Monday 27th April. 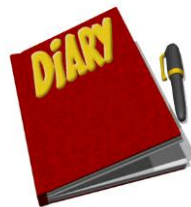
