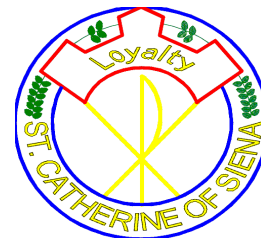

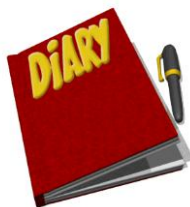

We hope you all have a lovely two-week break, and thank you for all your support this half term 🙏

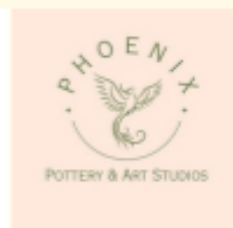
