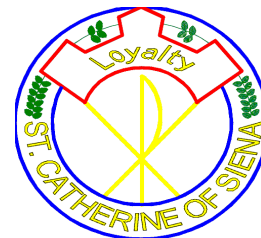

There will be no after school club on this day.



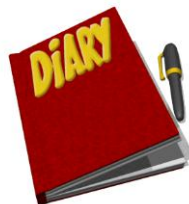
